# WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW BEFORE TRAVELLING TO COSTA RICA?

#### **Essential requirements**



#### TRAVEL INSURANCE

Acquisition of a travel insurance international or purchased in Costa Rica, that covers medical expenses caused by pandemics, including quarantine accommodation.

\*The National Insurance Institute of Costa Rica (INS) or Sagicor offers such insurance, you can purchase it either before your trip of at your arrival in SJO airport.

\*For international insurance policies, tourists must request a certificate from their insurance company, issued in English or Spanish, verifying at least the following three conditions.

(This certificate must be uploaded when filling out the electronic epidemiological HEALTH PASS):

- 1. Effectiveness of the policy during the visit to Costa Rica.
- 2. Guaranteed coverage of medical expenses in the event of becoming ill with the pandemic COVID-19 virus while in Costa Rica, for at least USD \$50,000 (fifty thousand United States Dollars).
  - 3. Includes minimum coverage of USD \$2,000 for lodging expenses issued as a result of the pandemic.

#### **EPIDEMIOLOGICAL FORM**

Each passenger must fill the official Ministry of Health's Epidemiological Form: <a href="mailto:salud.go.cr">salud.go.cr</a>

\*After completed, you will receive a QR code that you must carry on your cellphone, or a printed version. You will need the code to pass through customs in SJO airport.

#### WITHOUT SYMPTOMS

Please let the authorities at the airport know if you are experiencing symptoms which are compatible with covid-19 disease such as cough, fever, loss of smell, and others.

#### **PROTOCOLS**

Tourists must follow all the airport and local health protocols.

- Spas.


